

Code of Conduct Policy

This policy is to define the conduct that must be used while representing Taekwondo NB Inc. in any tae kwon do event. This policy oversees the actions of all athletes, coaches, referees, volunteers and staff. It is the responsibility of the individual to ensure they have a clear understanding of this policy and that they abide by it. The individual is representing this organization and act accordingly to reflect a positive image for themselves and this association.

This policy will only take effect for those athletes representing Taekwondo NB Inc. or are at an event that requires the recognition from this association.

It is expected that the individual is:

- Courteous to the host of any event, and those people around them that they may come in contact with.
- They are to carry themselves in the most professional manner during the time spent at the event.
- They are expected to be respectful to those in authority above them.
- There is to be no violent, disruptive, or vulgar behavior
- They are to abide by the rules and regulations of the event they are at, if applicable.
- They are not to abuse the privilege of being a representative of Taekwondo NB Inc.
- Responsible for reporting any inappropriate behavior to the Executive and Sanctioning Committee.

For violation of the items outlined above, the information will go before the Executive and Sanctioning Committee (if one established). It is the responsibility of these individuals to assess the severity of the violation and to determine the time frame of the penalty. The penalty for violating this policy will result in the sanctioning of said individual from participating in any event at the national and provincial level.

All individuals that leave this provincial region with the intention of representing the provincial body or this Association must have a signed Code of Conduct Confirmation form prior to participating in said event. If one is not on file with the current secretary for the current year, if not, the Executive reserves the right to ensure that this individual is not allowed to participate in said event, no matter what the event might be. Any cost incurred by the athlete will not be compensated by the Association nor will they be responsible for any resulting actions.

It is Taekwondo NB Inc. responsibility to ensure that this policy along with the Confirmation Form be circulated to the appropriate individuals to ensure that they are aware of the importance of this document and all information within.
